5. African lions live in families called "prides."

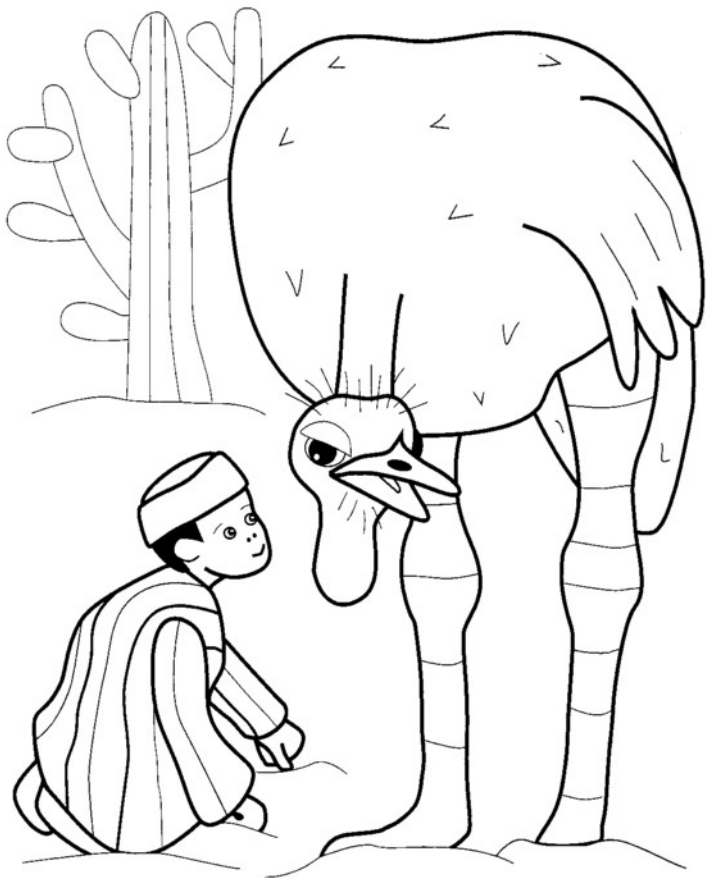


6. Leaves are a favorite food of the African giraffe.

8. The African ostrich is the largest living bird.



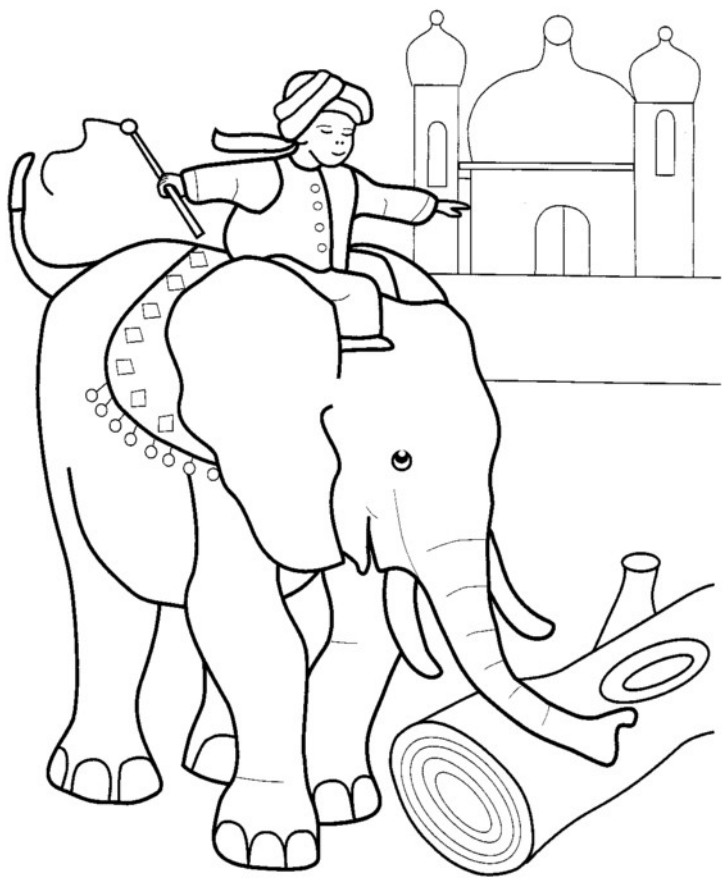
9. Natives of Malaysia call the orangutan,

14. The koala of Australia eats only eucalyptus leaves.

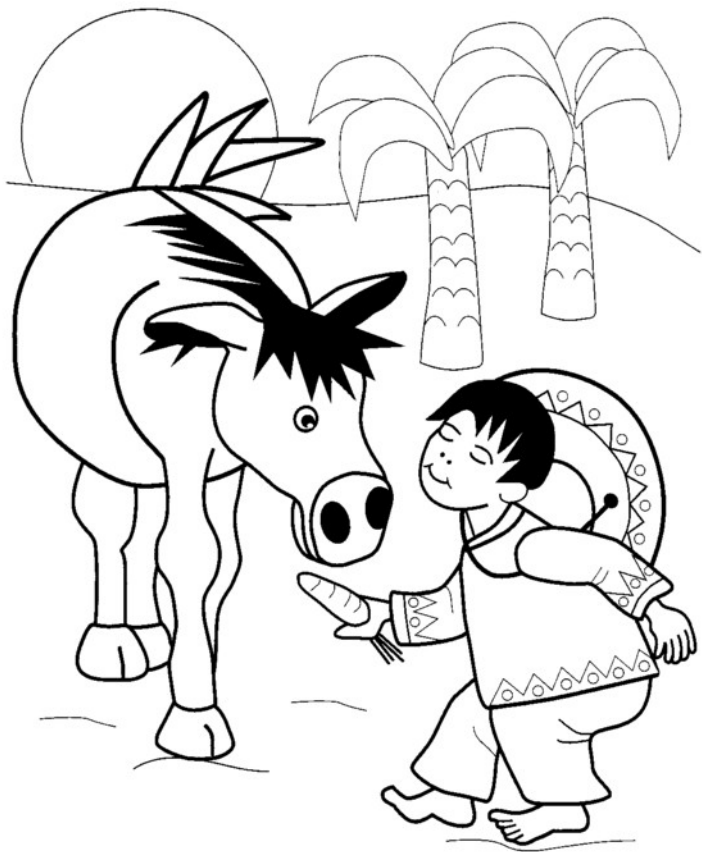


15. Australian kangaroo babies live in the mother's pouch.





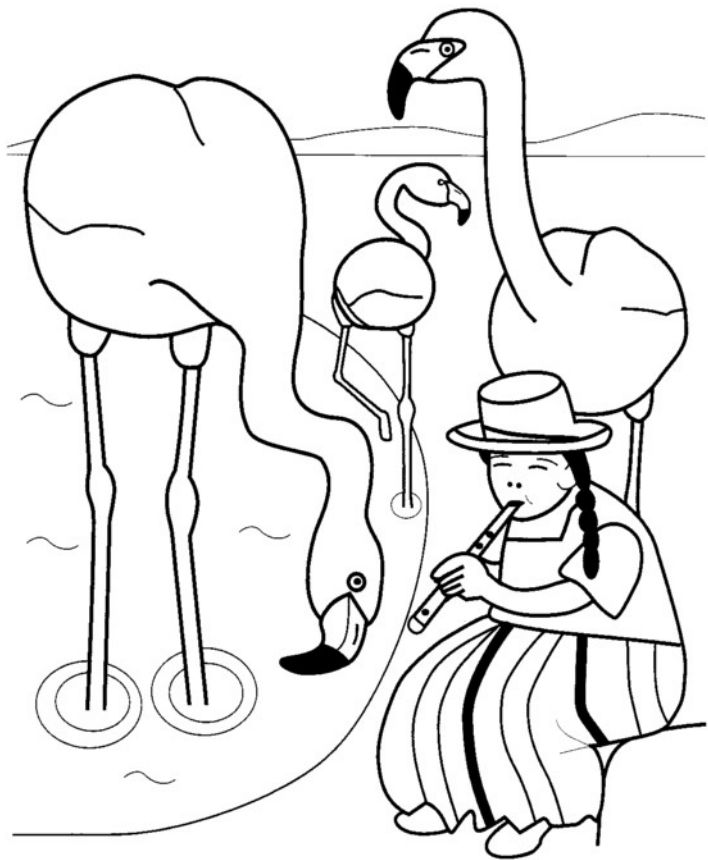
16. Pandas live in China and eat bamboo.

18. The Amazon parrot of Brazil uses its strong beak to crack seeds and nuts.



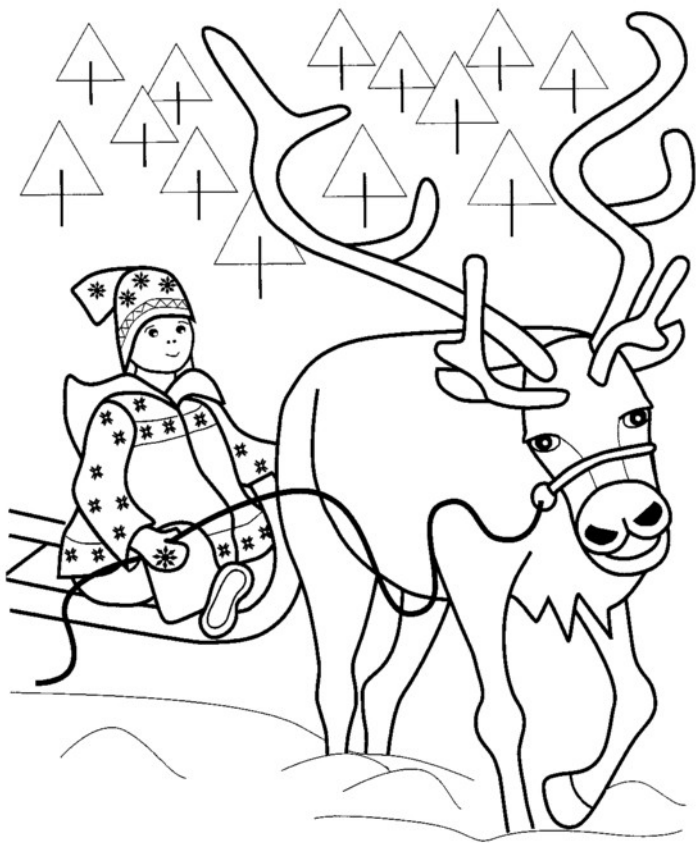
19. The flamingo of Peru has long legs for wading.



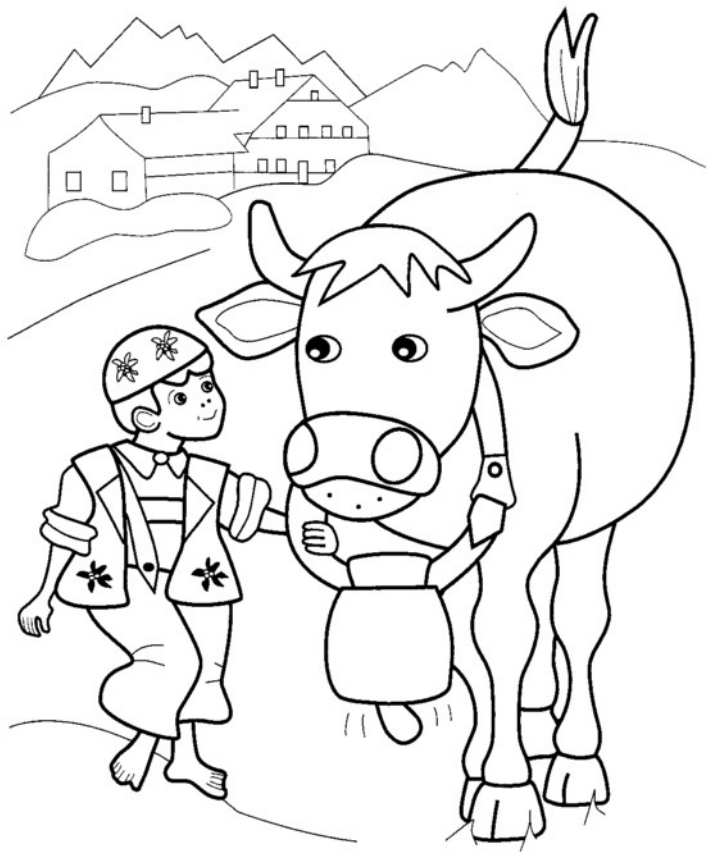
20. Spider monkeys of South America swing through the trees.

23. Swiss cows wear colorful bells around their necks.





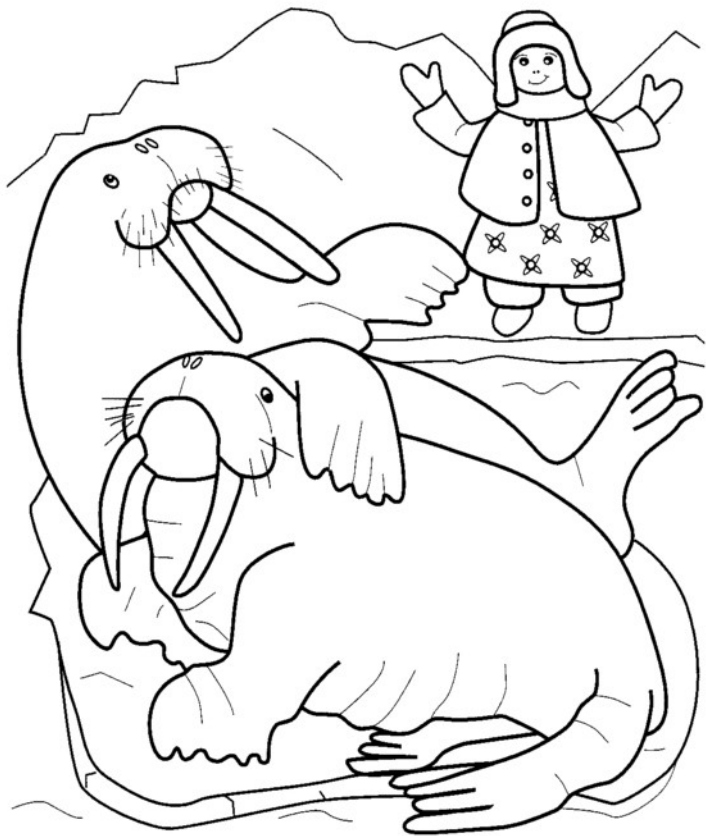
24. The sheep of Scotland provide wool for clothing.
